

<p>94/100</p>	<p>Domaine des Tourettes Delas Hermitage White 2014</p> <p>This has stunning fig, Anjou pear, Cavaillon melon and heather notes that glide along, lined with chamomile, anise and verbena details. The long, beguiling finish has a light bitter almond twinge for spine that lets everything drape effortlessly. Really gorgeous.</p>
<p>93/100</p>	<p>Les Bessards Delas Hermitage 2013</p> <p>Dense and fleshy in feel, with twinges of espresso and baker's chocolate running amid the core of dark plum, steeped currant and blackberry compote. The finish has a dark tobacco note lurking. This will need some time to settle in.</p>
<p>93/100</p>	<p>La Landonne Delas Côte-Rôtie 2013</p> <p>Very solid, with a loamy edge that melds slowly into the core of steeped plum and blackberry fruit, while smoldering alder, bay and dark olive notes flitter throughout. Cellar for maximum effect.</p>
<p>93/100</p>	<p>Clos Boucher Delas Condrieu White 2014</p> <p>Enticing, with creamed pear, apricot and nectarine notes, laced with fennel and star fruit hints. Lovely melon rind details frame the finish, which lingers effortlessly despite the tropical profile.</p>
<p>92/100</p>	<p>Domaine des Tourettes Delas Hermitage 2013</p> <p>Ripe for the vintage, with a fleshy core of plum compote and raspberry coulis flavors, backed by ample cocoa-edged grip that melds through the loam- and anise-accented finish.</p>
<p>91/100</p>	<p>Seigneur de Maugiron Delas Côte-Rôtie 2013</p> <p>A fresh, floral-edged style, with a bright violet frame around a core of sleek bitter cherry and dark plum fruit. The iron spine is well-embedded on the finish, while the pure fruit plays on.</p>
